#### We lead lowa's education efforts


- More than 20,000 education alumni in Iowa's 99 counties

## **Tuition & State Appropriations**



- Temporary Reduction of Salaries and Fringe Benefits
- Reduced General Fund support for Auxiliaries
- Eliminated and reduced positions
- Outsourced emails, calendars, and printing
- Restructured and closed select Academic programs
- Closed Malcolm Price Laboratory School
