 - Begin gathering in FY 06, worked with local areas and adopted by the State Board
- Visitation of Newborns; how many visits
 - o December 2004 Survey 100% of empowerment areas report reach families with a child between 0 and 3 months
 - 58 Empowerment Areas strive to have 60% of state funds support home visitation programs/family support; they all report, but not uniformly currently because of different programs. This will become consistent beginning n FY 06
