Collaborations between Iowa Braille School and Iowa Department for the Blind

Two year journey with the following results:

- IDB is part of the Interagency Agreement for Statewide System and member of the management team
- Shared professional development opportunities
- Joint sponsorship of Braille Challenge
- Shared access to education and transition databases
- Coordinated program scheduling
- Agreements for information sharing and participation in IEP meetings
- Plans to electronically merge the two libraries
- Mutual respect and understanding for common goals and differentiated methodologies between the two agencies

And as a consequence...

- Last month, 17 students participated in the Iowa Braille Challenge and this spring we'll find out how many qualified for the national competition. Last year 4 Iowa students qualified.
- Students no longer "fall through the cracks" in moving from school to adult services
- Professionals from IDB, IBS, and AEAs attend training sessions and learn together
- Programs offerings at IBS and IDB are coordinated to avoid duplication and schedule conflicts
- Parents and students benefit from IBS and IDB professional staff working collaboratively
- Students will learn one system for accessing library materials and will have access to a larger collection
