

Maintenance Issues






WHY WAS IT CREATED?

Environmental/Health Issues







DERELICT BUILDING GRANT PROGRAM

2011 grant funding round

39 applications received
\$1.2 million requested

D15 projects selected

- \$730,000 awarded
- Cash match of \$350,000





DERELICT BUILDING GRANT PROGRAM CITY OF EPWORTH PROJECT

Project generated 676 tons
Tipping Fee-\$37 x 676 = \$25,012AORTH
Project diverted 656 tons (97%)
Project saved City \$23,000 in lanchill fee
Contractor presented City with check reuse materials.
City received additional \$3,000 from set



DERELICT BUILDING GRANT PROGRAM CITY OF GUTHRIE CENTER PROJECT

Project generated 312 tons
 Tipping Fee-\$45 x 312 = \$14,040.
 Project diverted 238 tons (76%)
 Project saved City \$10,710 in landfill fees

DERELICT BUILDING GRANT PROGRAM CITY OF IDA GROVE PROJECT

Project generated 1060 tons
Tipping Fee-\$42 x 1060 = \$44,520.
Project diverted 818 tons (77%)
Project saved City \$34,365 in landfill fees



DERELICT BUILDING GRANT PROGRAM

2013 grant funding round

37 applications received
\$1.5 million requested
19 projects selected
\$497,000 awarded
\$255,000 cash match





DERELICT BUILDING GRANT PROGRAM CITY OF OLIN PROJECT

□Project generated 36 tons □Tipping Fee-\$46 x 36 = \$1,656. □Project diverted 19 tons (52%) □Project saved City \$828 in landfill fees*

DERELICT BUILDING GRANT PROGRAM CITY OF SIOUX RAPIDS PROJECT

Project generated 492 tons
 Tipping Fee-\$50 x 492 = \$24,600.
 Project diverted 443 tons (90%)
 Project saved City \$22,150 in landfill fees
