# Silos & Smokestacks Requests State Support

Silos & Smokestacks National Heritage Area respectfully requests \$200,000 from the State of Iowa in FY2014 to support continued agricultural education and preservation.

For more than 15 years, Silos & Smokestacks has been working to tell lowa's agricultural story primarily through \$9,550,000 in federal appropriations. # Making an Impact

Each year, over 3.4 million people visit lowa through the National Heritage Area where they learn about America's agricultural legacy and its connection to everyday life.

Our educational programs reach more than 200,000 people annually. Specifically, Bus Grants have provided 260 lowa Schools with transportation funds, connecting more than 14,500 school children directly to farms and their ag heritage.

In addition, over 350 lowa communities have received grants totaling \$1.75 million to tell their ag stories.
