## TOOLS FOR THE LEGISLATURE TO CONSIDER WHICH COULD BE USED TO EQUALIZE JUDICIAL WORKLOADS

- 1. Change jurisdiction of magistrates, and district associate and associate juvenile court judges. See attachment "A" for relevant Code sections regarding the jurisdiction of these judgeships.
- 2. Authorize voluntary transfers and transfers by attrition of district associate and associate juvenile court judges.
- 3. Change judgeship formulas that distribute judgeships throughout the state for district court, district associate court, juvenile court, and magistrate court. See attachment "B" for relevant Code sections regarding the formulas.
- 4. Review the best practices of each district and implement the best practices that can be applied statewide.
- 5. Propose constitutional amendment authorizing more flexibility to move judicial personnel among the judicial districts.
