Purposes—

1. Protect Iowa's consumers and producers of agricultural products
2. Facilitate the marketing of Iowa agricultural products
3. Provide for rural economic development

Bureaus—

1. Animal Industry Bureau—Regulates Iowa's livestock and pet industries. Regulates the movement and health/testing of livestock.
2. Dairy Products Control Bureau—Inspects dairy farms and plants to assure the conditions under which Iowa's fluid milk and manufactured milk is produced and processed.
3. Meat and Poultry Inspection Bureau—Inspects and licenses meat and poultry slaughter and processing facilities in Iowa that produce products for sale within the state of Iowa.
4. Weights and Measures Bureau—Licenses and inspects commercial weighing and measures devices including, but not limited to, gas pumps, grocery store scales, livestock scales and moisture meters.
9. Iowa Board of Veterinary Medicine—Licenses and disciplines Iowa's doctors of veterinary medicine.

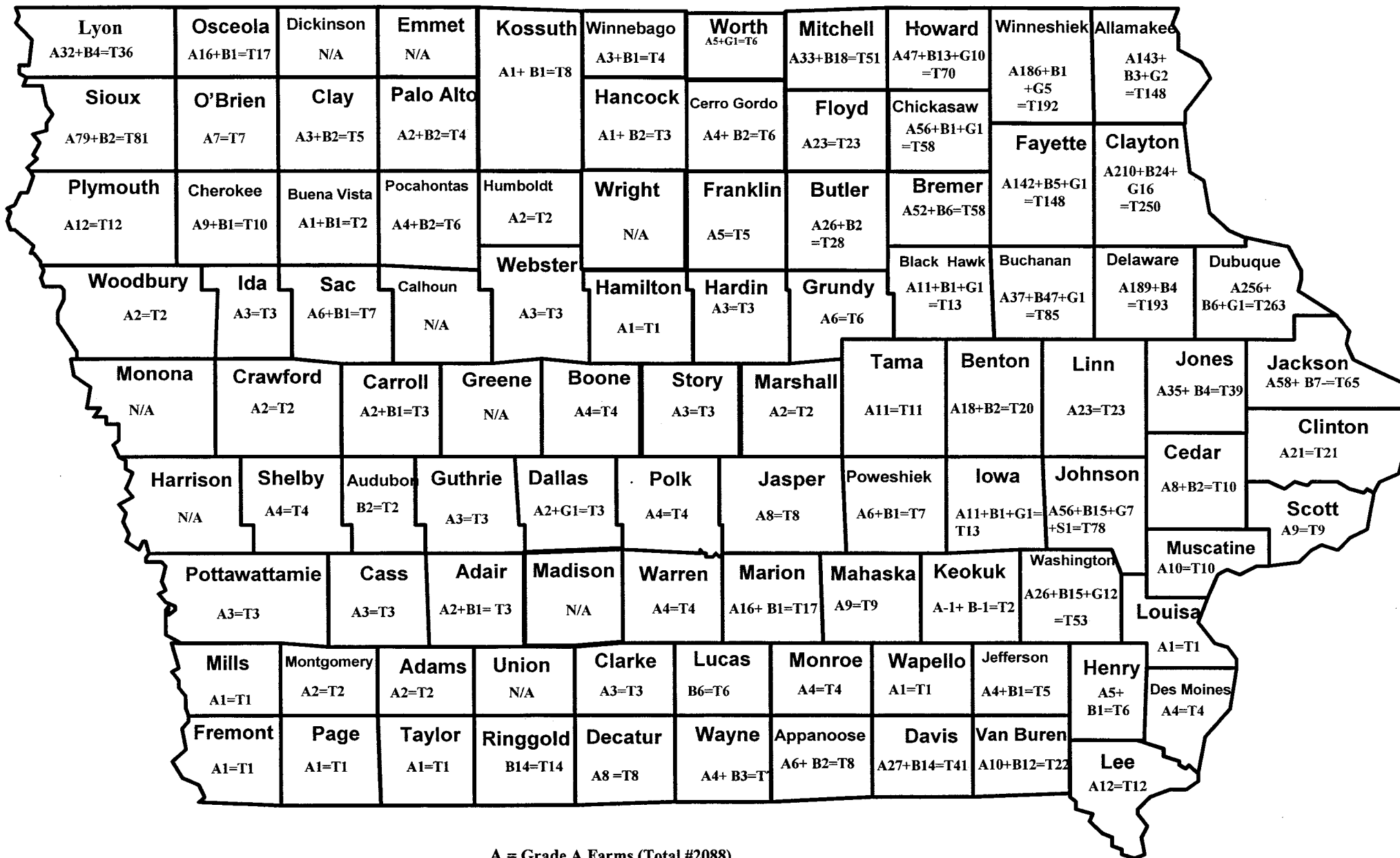
