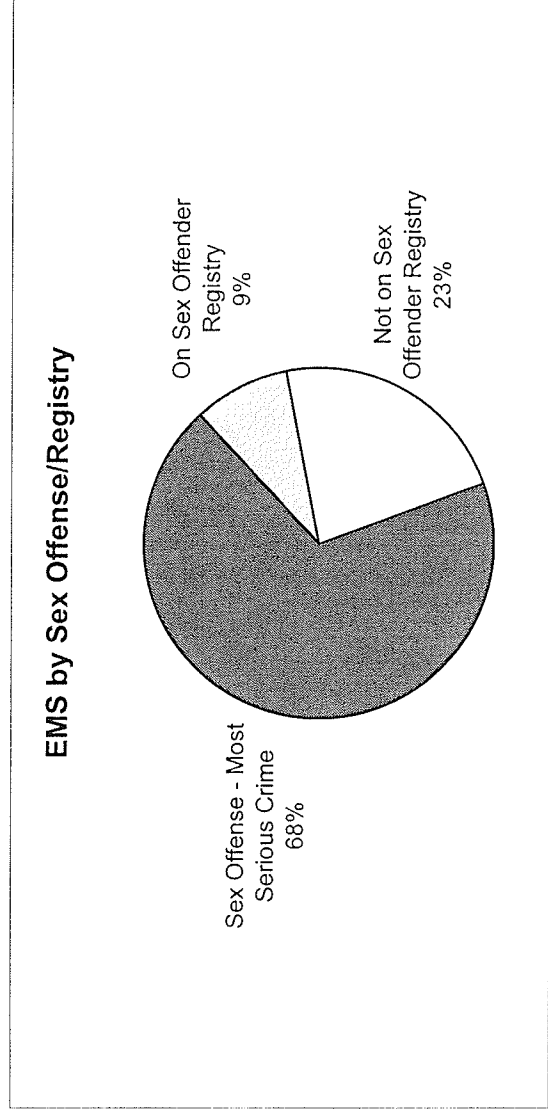
**Update:**
