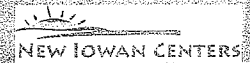

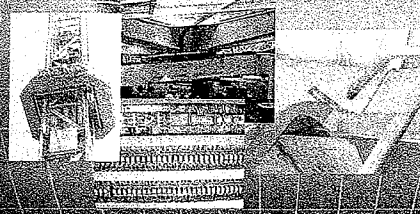

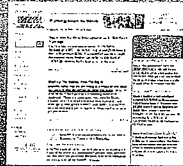

Final Thoughts

- Statistics from FY05
- Iowans received 388,579 different types of services
- Businesses posted 421,984 job openings
- The New Iowan Centers provided 3,340 employers with trainings, translation services, immigration updates and staffing assistance

Results

- 7,979 contractors registered
- 370 private sector OSHA consultations covering 71,310 employees
- As a result, 1,499 serious hazards were identified

Results

- 1,552 amusement rides inspected
- 3,392 elevator operating permits issues
- 20,368 reported workplace injuries resulting in 3,443 petitions for benefits
- 29,664 requests for workers' compensation information
