- ☑ How many students attend the on-campus program at the Iowa Braille and Sight Saving School (Vinton) in 2005-06? 34
  - General method is a state of that number, how many are academic students? 14
    - ♦ 3 students might be considered for post-secondary academic education
    - Students read and write in Braille
  - - ♦ 5 students use wheelchairs
    - 6 students are non-verbal
    - ♦ 16 students are not toilet trained
    - 17 students cannot read either print or Braille
    - 17 students require assistance to move from place to place
- ☑ Has there been a decrease in the number of on-campus students?


Yes. In the past 20 years, the on-campus enrollment has decreased by 32 students (-48.5%) from 66 in 1985-86 to 34 in 2005-06.



  - ← How much was spent on instruction? \$1,136,132 (28%)
  - How much was spent on special services (e.g., speech pathology)? \$297,862 (7%)

- ☑ How much did IBSSS spend for off-campus statewide services in FY 2005 (for more than 500 students)? \$1,298,946 (27%)
