Please note that Asian and Native American release groups are small, with the former typically numbering fewer than 40 per year and the latter fewer than 80. Therefore, changes in recidivism rates for these groups from year to year are not considered meaningful; that is, the varying makeup of these small release groups with regard to offender age, crime type, risk level, etc., are influencing the fluctuating recidivism rates.

The lower recidivism rate for Hispanic offenders is largely influenced by a higher percentage of this group receiving paroles to detainers compared to other groups.
