

FY16 Appropriations Request

- Operating Appropriations:
 - 1.75% increase, \$3.17 million
 - Hire faculty in signature, high-growth areas
 - Academic advising/student support
 - Learning analytics
 - Personalized learning
 - Upgrade learning space & IT
 - > Third tuition freeze





FY16 Appropriations Request

- Agriculture Experiment Station: \$1.04 million
 - Livestock odor management
 - Animal care and well-being






FY16 Appropriations Request

- Extension and Outreach: \$319,668
 - Workforce creation/development, technical assistance related to biosciences, advanced manufacturing, IT



- Nutrient management, water and soil conservation/quality, lowa Local Food and Farm Initiative
- Livestock Disease Research: \$3,025





Student Innovation Center



- \$80 million project of which ISU will privately raise \$40 million
 - √ \$20 million private commitment
- Support fabrication, large-scale, student interaction, hands-on and discovery-based learning, and co-curricular activities


Growing Demand for an ISU Degree

Serve more Iowa students (20,260)

Majority of students in 74/99 counties attend ISU

High growth areas:

- ✓ Agriculture (70%)
- ✓ Engineering (66%)
- √ Biosciences (55%)



Performance Based Funding

- \$6.3 million
 - Currently receive \$9,155/resident student
 - Strengthen programs that ensure student success and affordability
 - Model provides transparency, accountability, and flexibility
