


VeraSun Background

- Founded in Brookings, SD in 2001
- Publicly-traded company, listed on the New York Stock Exchange under the symbol VSE
- 1 BGY of production when new plants come online by end of 2008






VeraSun Production Facilities





The VeraSun Production Process






Products

110 Million Gallon-Per-Year Facility



- •39 Million Bushels of Corn Delivered Annually
- Approximately 110,000 bushels of corn ground daily
- Almost 40,000 truck deliveries of locallygrown corn annually



ETHANOL

- •Shipped by unit train
- •Each rail car holds approximately 29,000 gallons of ethanol
- •A unit train can be anywhere from 80 cars to more than 100 cars long



DISTILLERS GRAINS

- •1,000 tons of DDGS and 250 tons WDGS produced daily
- •350,000 tons of DDGS produce annually





Distillers Grains

- Co-product of ethanol production
- Non-fermentable component of the corn kernel (protein, fat, fiber)
- High energy, high protein digestible feedstuff
- Inclusions vary per species
- Available as dry (DDGS) and modified (MDGS)



DDGS Benefits

- Stable Shelf life allows for storage
- Versatile Useful for both ruminant and nonruminant species
- Economical Competitively priced to other protein and energy sources.
- Delivered or FOB Plant





DDGS Guaranteed Analysis (DM)

- Minimum Crude Protein 26%
- Minimum Crude Fat 8%
- Maximum Crude Fiber 15%
- Maximum Ash 8%
- Maximum Sulfur 1%





DDGS Logistics

- DDGS are available by truck or rail
- Expect to ship 60 rail cars of DDGS per plant every week
- Contracts
 - Monthly
 - Spot
 - Fixed pricing or possibly basis pricing





MDGS Benefits

- Conditions Feed Ration Mixes well and binds other ingredients while improving overall palatability
- Adjusts Ration Moisture To improve digestion and increase total intake
- Higher Oil Content Increases energy concentration/density





MDGS Guaranteed Analysis (DM)

- Minimum Crude Protein 10%
- Minimum Crude Fat 6%
- Maximum Crude Fiber 5%
- Maximum Ash 4%
- Maximum Sulfur .5%





MDGS Logistics

- MDGS are available locally within 150 miles of the production facility
- Contracts
 - Monthly
 - Spot
 - Fixed pricing or possibly basis pricing





Quality Assurance

- Testing of both MDGS and DDGS
 - Test weekly for Protein, Fat, Fiber, and Moisture
 - Test once a month for AA, Trace Minerals, and Toxins
- Tests performed by one laboratory for all VeraSun Sites to ensure consistency
- In-house moisture testing is performed several times a day to limit variability
- Retain samples are pulled from each truckload or railcar for future reference



VeraSun Announced Innovative Process for Biodiesel Production

- Oil extracted from distillers grains for biodiesel production
- Allows the creation of two biofuels from the same feedstock
- Removing the oil also enhances the resulting distillers grains as a livestock feed by concentrating protein and reducing fat content





Opportunities for Producers

- Significant advantage to producers close to plants
 - Freight advantage
- Allows producers to utilize a valuable feed at a reasonable price
 - Assume 105-125% feed value of corn
 - Often priced at a lower than corn cost
 - Industry competition
 - Market demand



Challenges Facing the Industry

- Lack of standardized testing of Distillers Products
 - Numerous tests
 - Lack of continuity
- Sulfur
 - Negative perception industry wide
 - Not all companies have excessive levels
 - Lack of consumer knowledge
