Benefits to the employee are payable regardless of fault, and the Iowa Division of Workers' Compensation is responsible for deciding disputes over benefits claims between workers and employers. 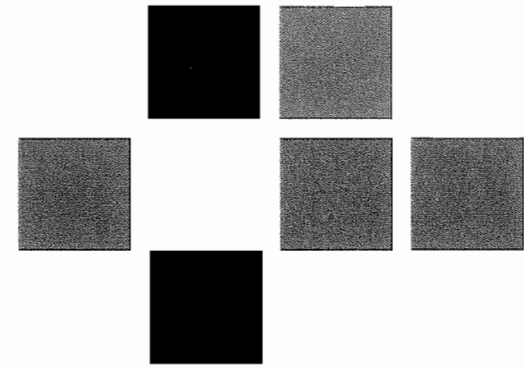
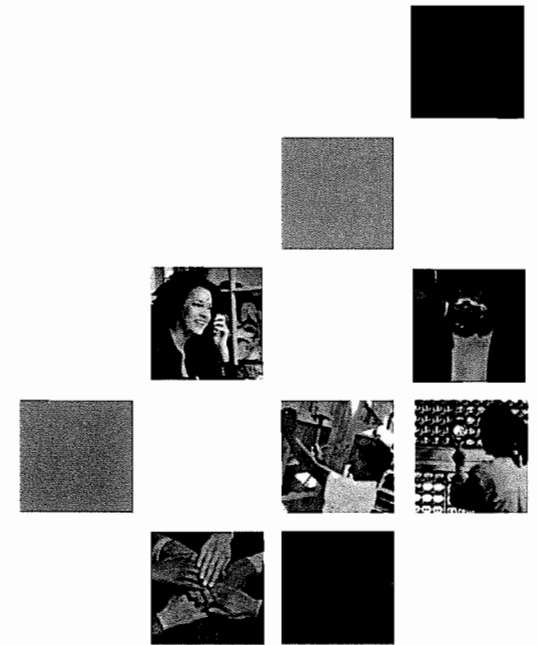
