Figure 1. Compensation Benefits Paid: \$4,192,162

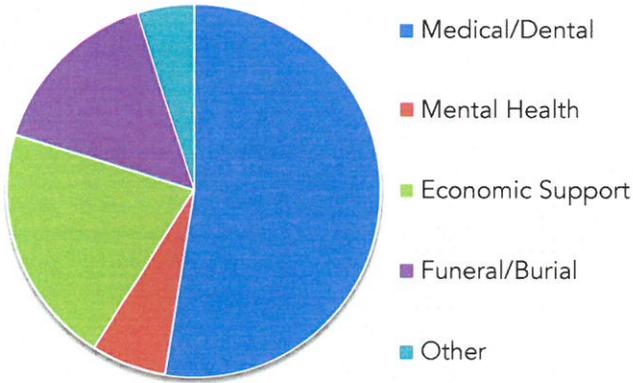


Figure 2. Further Detail for Other Compensation Benefits Paid

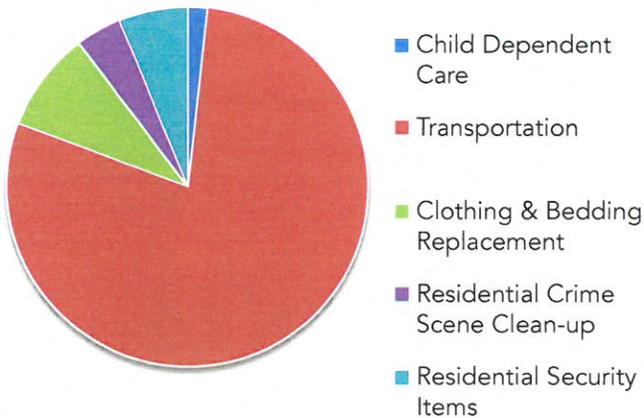


Figure 3. Compensation Application Determinations: 2,593 Received

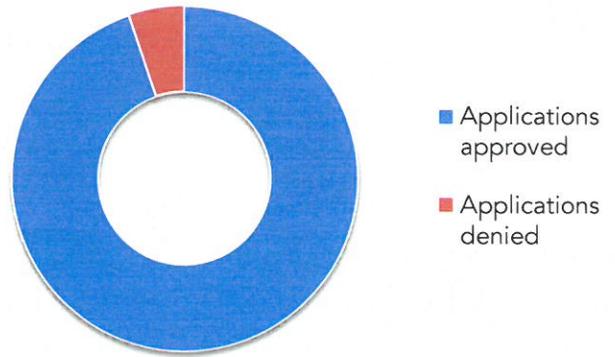
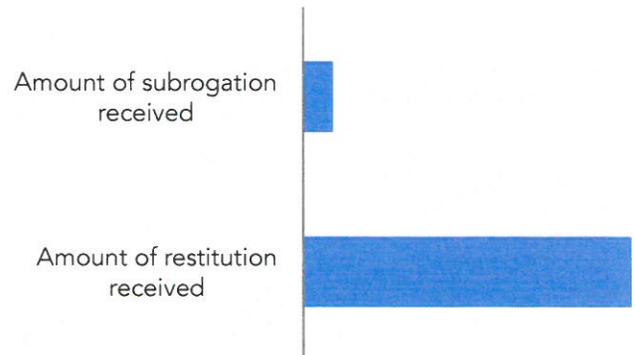

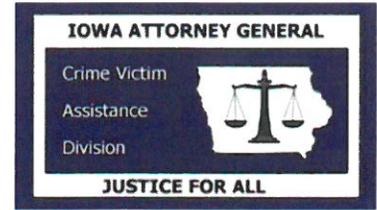


Figure 5. VINE Searches (2,037,533)

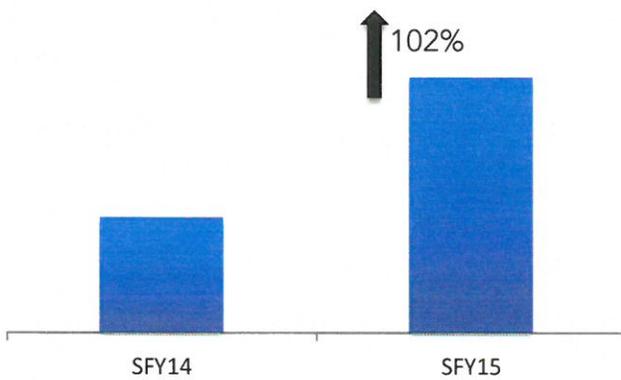


Figure 6. New VINE Registrations (54,401)

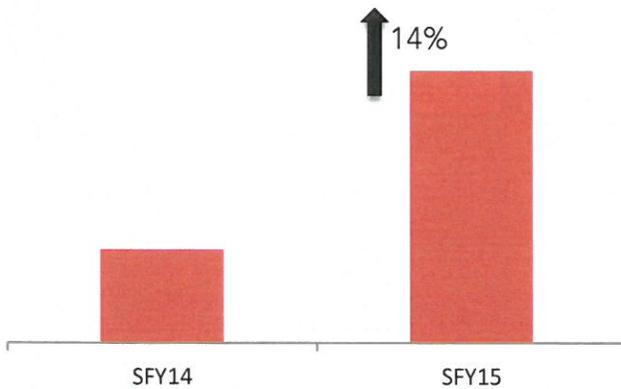


Figure 7. People Trained by the Crime Victims Assistance Division: 3,382

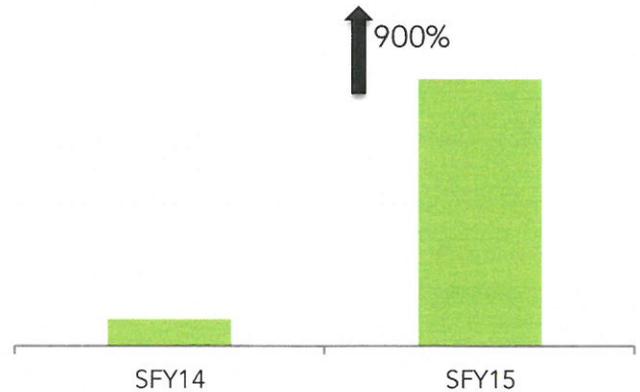
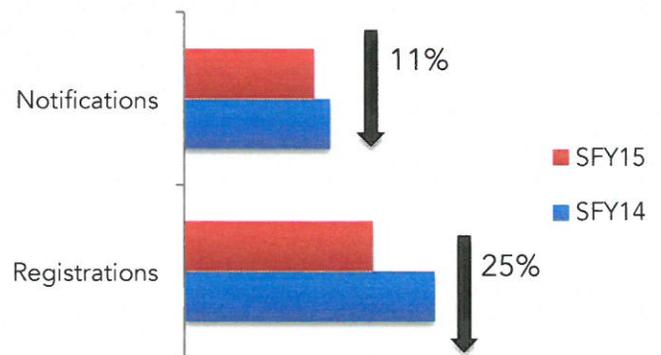


Figure 8. IPONDA Notifications (327) and Registrations (472)

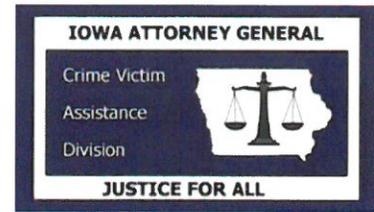
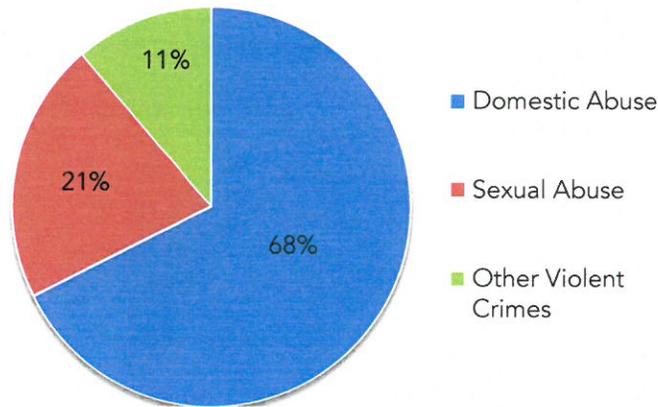


Figure 1. Total Crime Victims Served

Figure 2. SFY13 vs. SFY14 vs. SFY15 Victims Served

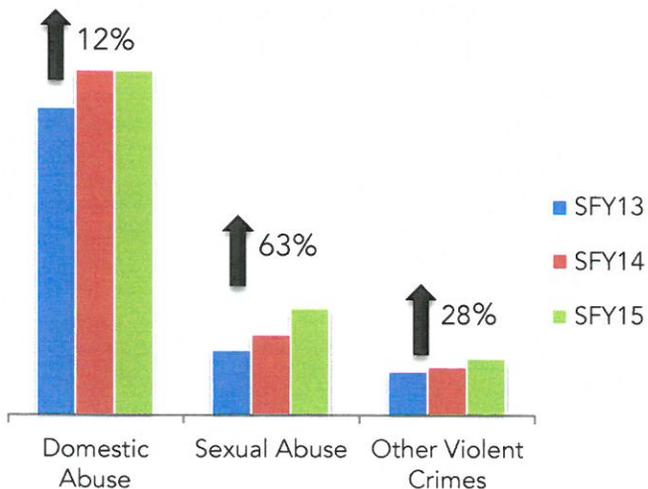


Figure 3. SFY14 vs. SFY15 Victims Sheltered

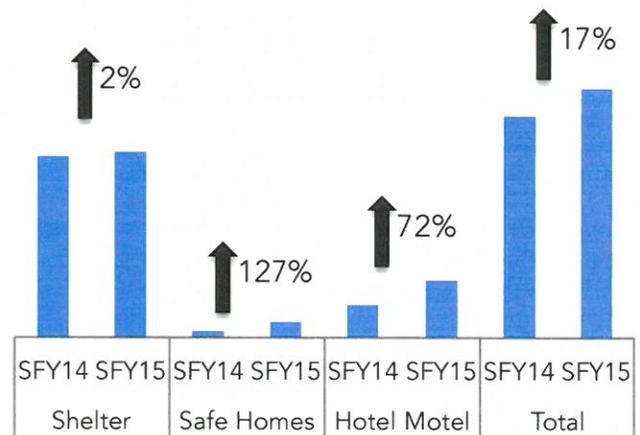


Figure 4. SFY14 vs. SFY15 Nights of Shelter

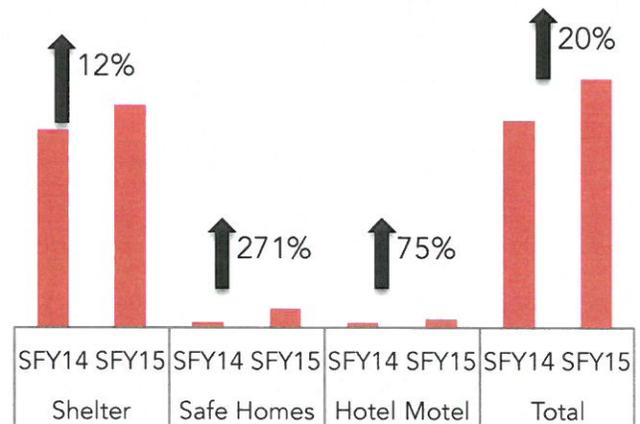


Figure 5. Shelter Vacancy Rates

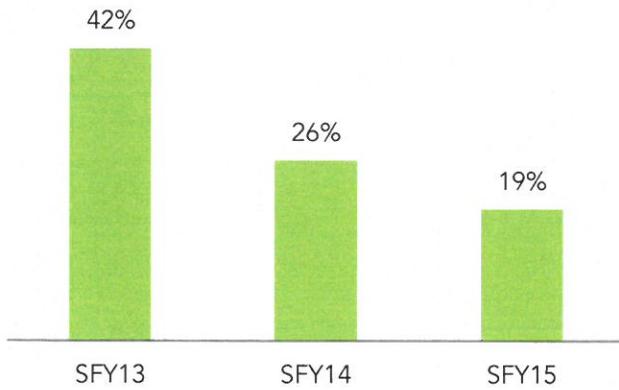


Figure 6. Diversion Services

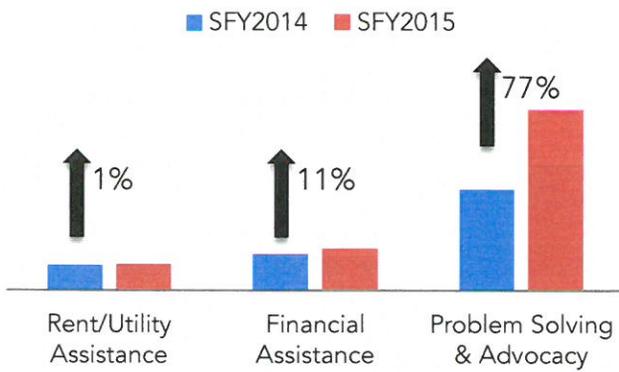


Figure 7. Victims Sheltered vs. Diverted

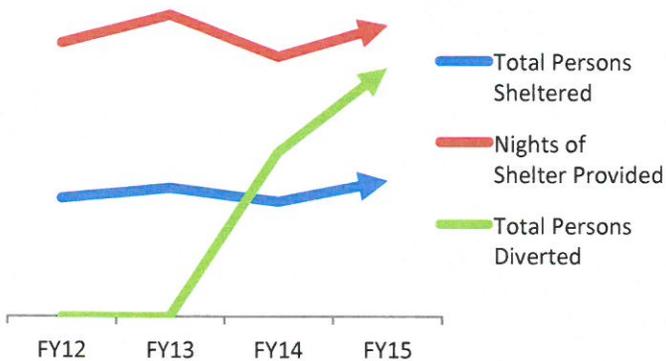


Figure 8. Individuals Reached through Presentations and Outreach

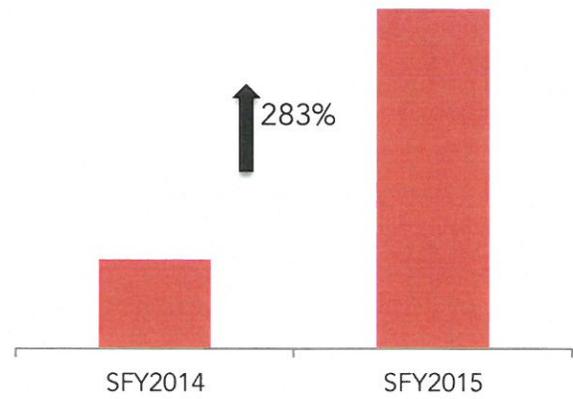


Figure 9. Number of Agencies Collaborating with Victim Programs

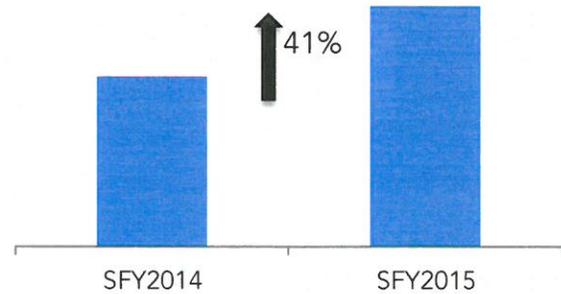
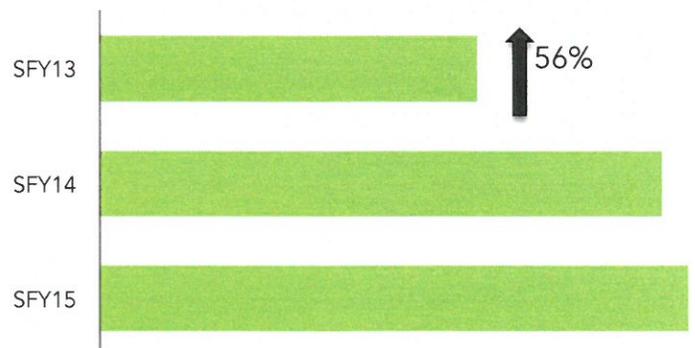


Figure 9. Number of Volunteers

Figure 1. DA, SA & SH Programs Expenses by Percentage Total: \$15,130,459

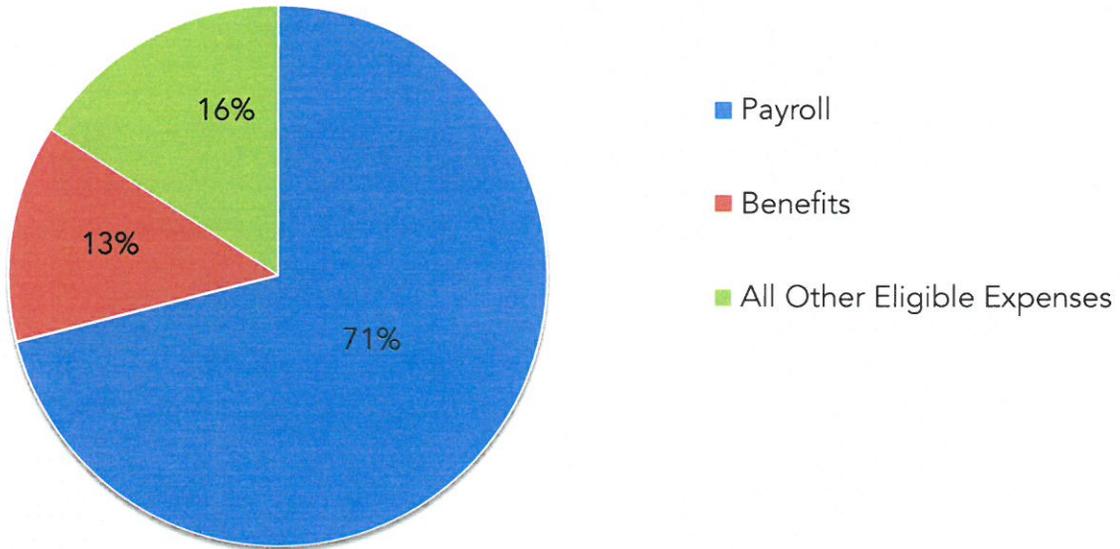
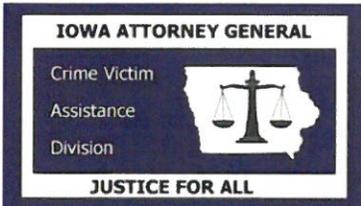


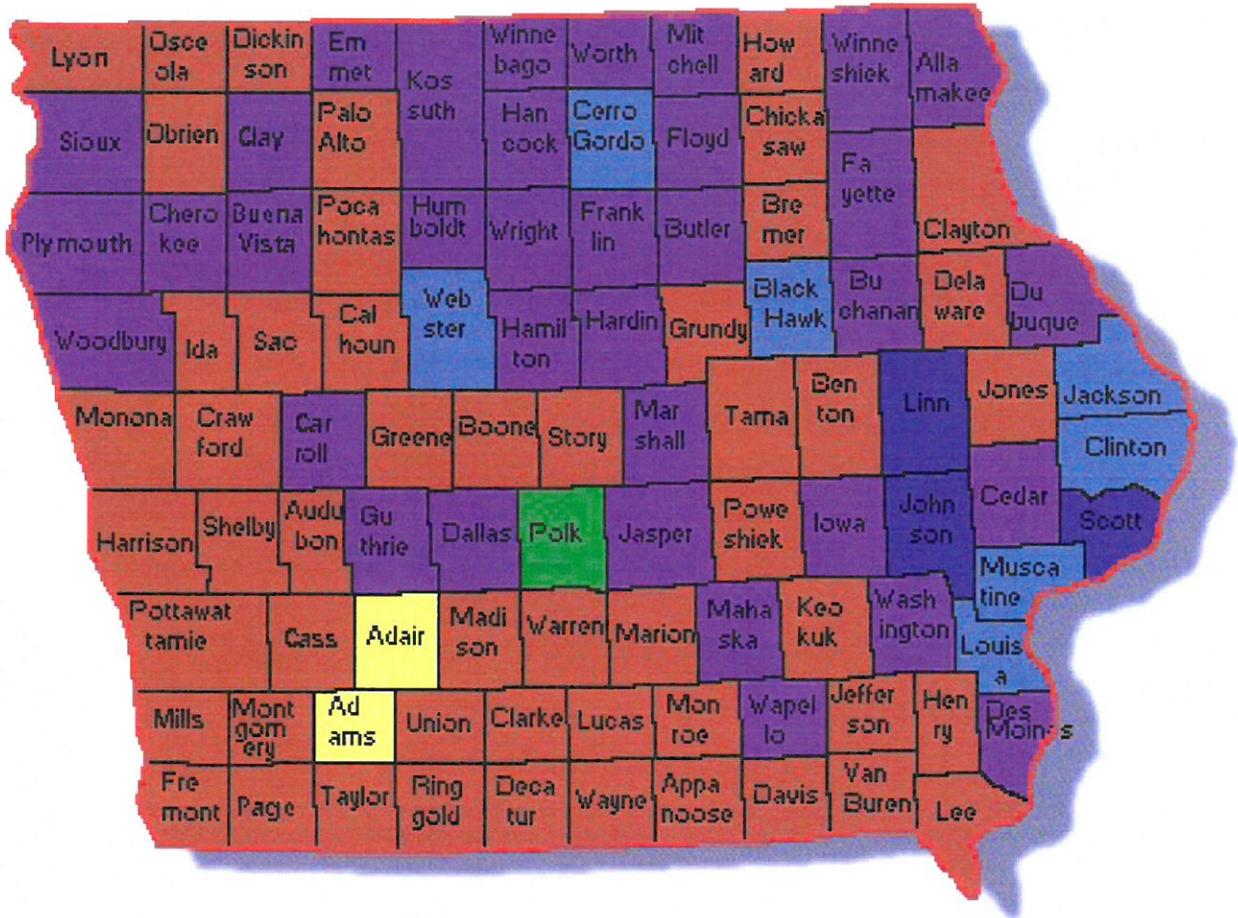
