

#### About Xenia Rural Water District

- Headquartered in Bouton, Iowa
- 117 Employees
- Providing service to Central and North Central Iowa
  - 13 counties
  - 14 communities



# **Bouton Cost Comparisons**

• Gravity Collection	\$437,000
• Low Pressure Collection	\$383,000
• STEP Collection	\$302,000
• Controlled Discharge Lagoon	\$225,000
• RGF Treatment	\$190,000
• Advantex Treatment System	\$175,000

## **Bouton Project Costs**

- Chosen project:
  - Low Pressure Collection
  - Pump to Perry (\$150,000)
- Total Construction Cost......\$423,000
- Total Project Cost......\$692,000
- \$692,000/68 Households = \$10,176.47

## **Bouton Funding**

• CDBG Funding\$136,00	0

- USDA Grant.....\$260,000
- USDA Loan.....\$296,000
- \$296,000/68 Households = \$4,352.94

# Linden Cost Comparisons

• Gravity Collection	\$665,000
• Low Pressure Collection	\$563,000
• STEP Collection	\$647,000
• Controlled Discharge Lagoon	\$275,000
• RGF Treatment	\$350,000

## Linden Project Costs

- Chosen project:
  - Low Pressure Collection
  - Controlled Discharge Lagoon
- Total Construction Cost.....\$838,000
- Total Other Costs......\$238,000 (Includes Engineering, Legal, Admin., etc.)
- Total Project Cost......\$1,076,000
- \$1,076,000/94 Households = \$11,446.81

## Linden Funding (Anticipated)

• CDBG Funding	\$226,000
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- USDA Grant.....\$360,000
- USDA Loan.....\$490,000
- Remaining project costs privately funded by Xenia
- \$490,000/94 Households = \$5,212.77

#### **General Costs**

- Electrical upgrades
  - In small rural communities, approximately 10-15% of homes need proper upgrades
- Abandonment of existing system
  - Must be properly disposed of
- Treatment
  - Can be pumped to larger city for treatment
  - Individual treatment options
- General excavating costs

## Funding Opportunities

- CDBG (Community Development Block Grant)
- USDA Loans & Grants
- DNR SRF Loan
- Planning and Design Loan

#### **CDBG**

- Community Development Block Grant
- Purpose is to increase employment opportunities for LMI individuals by increasing economic activity levels within the state
- Iowa cities under 50,000 population are eligible
- 51% of persons benefiting from project must be from LMI households
- Davis-Bacon Act has wage requirements
- Requires Environmental Assessment

#### **USDA Loans & Grants**

- 40 year loan
- Eligible groups:
  - Community based non-profit organizations
  - Public bodies (municipalities, counties, etc.)
- Maximum limits determined by project feasibility
- Up to 100% of project can be funded by loan
- Want least expensive system installed
- \$40 average monthly customer bill
  - LMI communities may be eligible to obtain USDA Grants to assist in lowering monthly bills
- Requires Environmental Assessment

#### **DNR SRF Loan**

- State Revolving Fund
- 30 year low interest loan
- Jointly administered
  - Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR)
  - Iowa Finance Authority (IFA)

## Planning and Design Loan

- 0% interest for up to 3 years
- Used to cover engineering and project development costs
- Cannot be used for land purchases
- Can be rolled into SRF loan or USDA loan

## **Project Steps**

- Meet with City Council
- Public Hearing
- Purchase land for lagoon site
- Facility Plan
- DNR Approval
- Election

## Sharing costs

- Labor and Machine/Equipment costs are shared between water and wastewater projects
- Travel to communities is built into rate structure for water system
- Sharing lowers Operation and Maintenance costs

#### Issues

- Availability of funds
- Getting rates low enough (\$40 avg.)

## Suggestions

- Same standards for all funding groups
- One general application
- Additional grant funds are needed to make projects feasible
