

Family Investment Program Average Monthly Caseload

FIP caseload has decreased steadily since 2012



*2018 average monthly caseload through December 2017

FIP Households

- Average FIP family:
 - Single Caucasian woman
 - 20 to 29 years old
 - High school degree or equivalent education
 - Two children under the age of 6
- In SFY17, the average monthly FIP payment was:
 - \$345.68 for 1-parent households = \$4,148 annually;
 - \$431.07 for 2-parent households = \$5,173 annually; and
 - \$269.94 for caretaker households = \$3,239 annually.
- Average length of time receiving FIP:
 - 1-parent households: 21 months
 - 2-parent households : 9 months
 - Caretaker households : 29 months
