

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the safety of state employees and the public is of utmost importance; and

WHEREAS, that safety requires the speedy and orderly evacuation of personnel from a building in the event of a fire; and

WHEREAS, it is not possible to safely evacuate the capitol building in the event of a fire especially from those areas on the second and third floors which have been "double decked" NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE IOWA GENERAL ASSEMBLY, That a communication be sent to the Director of General Services indicating the support of the council for the planning and installation of adequate fire evacuation facilities in the State Capitol Building.
