SUBJECT: Bids for the Session Laws - 1st Session 68th General Assembly

On April 2, 1979, the bids for 4,500 copies of the Session Laws for the First Regular Session of the 68th General Assembly were opened. The bidding was based on specifications that the contractor would print the Session Laws from camera ready pages as stipulated earlier by the Legislative Council.

Bids were received from two firms, and they are as follows:

My recommendation is to purchase the 2,500 hardbound copies and 2,000 softbound copies for a total price of \$23,907.00 from Desaulniers and Company. The softbound copies are used for the distribution of the Session Laws to State agencies. The hardbound copies are the books we sell to attorneys and others.
