The subcommittee discussed a proposed contract between the Legislature and Haskins & Sells to conduct a program evaluation of the Title XIX Program in Iowa.

Senator Doderer moved that the subcommittee recommend to the Legislative Council the contract be approved with the starting date moved to July 1, 1976.

The motion was amended by Senator Palmer as follows: The contract as presented be recommended for approval by the Legislative Council after consulting with the Human Resources Joint Subcommittee on Appropriations concerning the starting date of the study.
