June 14, 1978

The Legislative Service Committee of the Legislative Council met at 9:00 a.m., June 14, 1978 and reviewed personnel and budget recommendations of the directors of the agencies for which the Legislative Council is charged by law to set policies. The Legislative Service Committee makes the following recommendations to the Council:

1. That the recommendations of the Director of the Legislative Service Bureau be approved as mailed to the members of the Council. Information indicating the effect of such recommendations is attached.
2. That the recommendations of the Legislative Fiscal Director be approved as mailed to members of the Council. Information indicating the effect of such recommendations is attached.
3. That the attached recommendations of the Citizens' Aide be approved. (It should be noted that two recommended position reclassifications for existing employees are to take effect immediately, in order to utilize funds available under H.F. 634 of the 1977 Session.)
4. That the attached recommendations of the Executive Secretary of the Temporary State Land Preservation Policy Commission be approved.

The Service Committee chairman appointed a subcommittee consisting of Representative Gregory Cusack, Chair, Senator Phil Hill, and Representative Don Doyle for the purpose of consulting with the Merit Employment Department and the Directors of the Legislative Service Bureau and Legislative Fiscal Bureau in regard to developing appropriate qualifications and salary level for the position of the Director of the Legislative Oversight Bureau. If the Legislative Oversight Bureau is funded it will be the responsibility of the Legislative Council to appoint the director of the Legislative Oversight Bureau.

Citizens' Aide Bill Angrick presented his concern in regard to maintaining the Office of Citizens' Aide in its existing quarters. The Service Committee requested the Director of the Legislative Service Bureau to arrange for the Director of the Department of General Services to meet with the Legislative Service Committee at its meeting in July.
