NATURAL RESOURCES VISITATION COMMITTEE

Sept. 10 Ledges State Park

To view and discuss possible damage to the Ledges as a result of high water from the Saylorville Dam.

Sept. 19-20 Upper Iowa Including Backbone State Park and The Volga River Project

The Committee requests permission to hold a Public Hearing on the Upper Iowa River Project. An environmental impact study has been recently released by the Department of the Interior which has caused a disturbance amongst the Citizens of Northeast Iowa. A compromise is needed whereby farmers can pasture land but public can have access to scenic view of river. Legislators from Northeast Iowa, members of Upper Iowa River Assoc., Chambers of Commerce from Cresco and Decorah, Supervisors from Howard, Winneshiek and Allemaque Counties, and representatives from Sierra Club and Isaak Walton League would be invited to public hearing.

Maintenance of State Parks by Conservation Commission would be main emphasis of Park visits.
