[SF 467](#) COMMITTEE BILL -- A bill for an act relating to and making appropriations involving state government, by Seng providing for agriculture, natural resources, and environmental protection. (Formerly [SSB 1319](#).) By Appropriations. (Eligible: 04/02/2009.)

[SF 461](#) COMMITTEE BILL -- A bill for an act repealing the authorization to use local sales and services tax revenue Bolkcom to fund urban renewal projects and including an effective date provision. (Formerly [SSB 1211](#).) By Ways & Means. (Eligible: 04/01/2009.)

[SF 458](#) COMMITTEE BILL -- A bill for an act authorizing cities to establish storm water drainage system utility Wilhelm districts for purposes of special assessments. (Formerly [SSB 1273](#) & [SF 362](#).) By Ways & Means. (Eligible: 03/30/2009.)

[SF 457](#) COMMITTEE BILL -- A bill for an act relating to disaster recovery by legalizing certain actions taken and Hogg proceedings conducted by cities and counties in response to a natural disaster, designating certain activities as essential corporate purposes and essential county purposes, amending provisions related to local bonding authority and contract letting requirements, amending provisions relating to emergency contract letting requirements for joint governmental entities and institutions under the control of the board of regents, amending provisions related to city and county lease contracts and loan agreements, modifying provisions relating to municipal support of certain projects, amending provisions related to expenditures from certain revolving loan funds, and including effective date and retroactive applicability date provisions. (Formerly [SSB 1239](#) & [SF 363](#).) By Ways & Means. (Eligible: 03/30/2009.)

[HF 687](#) COMMITTEE BILL -- A bill for an act relating to certain reporting requirements or actions required of the Schmitz department of education, school districts, accredited nonpublic schools, and community colleges. (Formerly [HSB 26](#)) By Education. (Eligible: 03/30/2009.)

[HF 311](#) COMMITTEE BILL -- A bill for an act requiring health care benefit coverage for certain medically necessary Rielly prosthetic devices and providing an applicability date. (Formerly [HSB 141](#)) By Commerce. (Eligible: 03/24/2009.)
