



## 1995 Iowa Legislative Session Timetable\*

\* If 1994 rules remain unchanged

### **JANUARY 9**

First day of session

### **FEBRUARY 24**

(Friday of 7th week) Final day for individual requests for bill drafts to Legislative Service Bureau

### **\*MARCH 17**

(Friday of 10th week) Final date for House bills to be reported out of House committees (and Senate bills out of Senate committees)

### **MARCH 20-24**

(11th week) House considers only House bills and unfinished business (Senate considers only Senate bills and unfinished business)

### **MARCH 27-APRIL 7**

(12th & 13th week) Debate not limited by rule

### **\*APRIL 7**

(Friday of 13th week) Final date for Senate bills to be reported out of House committees (and House bills out of Senate committees)

### **APRIL 10-APRIL 14**

(14th week) House considers only Senate bills and unfinished business (Senate considers only House bills and unfinished business)

### **APRIL 17**

(Beginning of 15th week) Amendments in the House need not be filed on the day preceding floor debate

### **APRIL 17**

(Beginning of 15th week) Only the following bills are eligible for consideration:

- Appropriations Bills
- Ways and Means Bills
- Legalizing Acts
- Bills cosponsored by Majority and Minority Leaders of one House
- Companion Bills sponsored by House and Senate Majority Leaders
- Conference Committee Reports
- Bills passed by both Houses in different forms
- Concurrent or Simple Resolutions
- Bills on the Veto Calendar
- Administrative Rules Review Committee Bills
- Joint Resolutions nullifying Administrative Rules
- Unfinished Business

### **APRIL 28**

110th day of the session (Per diem expenses end)

**\*The March 17 and April 7 committee deadlines do not apply to Appropriations Bills, Ways and Means Bills, Bills cosponsored by Majority and Minority Leaders of one House, Companion Bills sponsored by the Majority Leaders of both Houses after consultation with the respective Minority Leaders, Concurrent or Simple Resolutions, Joint Resolutions nullifying Administrative Rules, Legalizing Acts, and Administrative Rules Review Committee Bills.**
