



2001 Iowa Legislative Session Timetable*

*If 1999 rules remain unchanged (see JR 20)

JANUARY 8 First day of session

FEBRUARY 16 (Friday of 6th week) Final day for individual requests for bill drafts to Legislative Service Bureau (SR 27 and HR 29)

****MARCH 16** (Friday of 10th week) Final date for House bills to be reported out of House committees (and Senate bills out of Senate committees)

MARCH 19-23 (11th week) House considers only House bills and unfinished business (Senate considers only Senate bills and unfinished business)

MARCH 26-April 6 (12th & 13th week) Debate not limited by rule

****April 6** (Friday of 13th week) Final date for Senate bills to be reported out of House committees (and House bills out of Senate committees)

APRIL 9-13 (14th week) House considers only Senate bills and unfinished business (Senate considers only House bills and unfinished business)

APRIL 16 (Beginning of 15th week) House Amendments need not be filed on the day preceding floor debate (HR 31.8)

APRIL 16 (Beginning of 15th week) Only the following bills are eligible for consideration:

- Appropriations Bills
- Ways and Means Bills
- Legalizing Acts
- Bills co-sponsored by Majority and Minority Leaders of one House
- Companion Bills sponsored by House and Senate Majority Leaders
- Conference Committee Reports
- Concurrent or Simple Resolutions
- Bills Passed by both Houses in different forms
- Bills on the Veto Calendar (JR 23)
- Administrative Rules Review Committee Bills
- Committee bills related to delayed administrative rules(Iowa Code Sec.17A.8(9))
- Joint Resolutions nullifying Administrative Rules
- Redistricting Bills
- Unfinished Business

April 27 110th calendar day of the session (Per diem expenses end)

****The March 16 and April 6 committee deadlines do not apply to Appropriations Bills, Ways and Means Bills, Bills co-sponsored by Majority and Minority Leaders of one House, Companion Bills sponsored by the Majority Leaders of both Houses after consultation with the respective Minority Leaders, Conference Committee Reports, Concurrent or Simple Resolutions, Redistricting bills, Joint Resolutions nullifying Administrative Rules, Legalizing Acts, Administrative Rules Review Committee Bills, and Committee bills related to delayed administrative rules(Iowa Code Sec.17A.8(9)).**
