JANUARY 13	First day of session (Iowa Code Sec. 2.1)
FEBRUARY 21	(Friday of 6 th week) Final day for individual requests for bill drafts to Legislative Service Bureau (SR 27 and HR 29)
MARCH 14**	(Friday of 9 th week) Final date for House bills to be reported out of House committees (and Senate bills out of Senate committees) (JR 20)
MARCH 24 - 28	(11 th week) House considers only House bills and unfinished business (Senate considers only Senate bills and unfinished business) (JR 20)
MARCH 31 - APRIL 11	(12 th & 13 th weeks) Debate not limited by rule
APRIL 11**	(Friday of 13 th week) Final date for Senate bills to be reported out of House committees (and House bills out of Senate committees) (JR 20)
APRIL 14 - 18	(14 th week) House considers only Senate bills and unfinished business (Senate considers only House bills and unfinished business) (JR 20)
APRIL 21	(Beginning of 15 th week) Amendments need not be filed on the day preceding floor debate (HR 31.8)
APRIL 21	(Beginning of 15 th week) Only the following bills are eligible for consideration: (JR 20) <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Appropriations Bills■ Ways and Means Bills■ Government Oversight Bills■ Legalizing Acts■ Bills co-sponsored by Majority and Minority Leaders of one House■ Companion Bills sponsored by Senate and House Majority Leaders■ Conference Committee Reports■ Concurrent or Simple Resolutions■ Bills passed by both Houses in different forms■ Bills on the Veto Calendar (JR 23)■ Administrative Rules Review Committee Bills■ Committee Bills related to delayed Administrative Rules [Iowa Code Sec. 17A.8 (9)]■ Joint Resolutions nullifying Administrative Rules■ Unfinished Business
MAY 2	110 th calendar day of the session [Per diem expenses end - Iowa Code Sec. 2.10(1)]

**The March 14 and April 11 committee deadlines do not apply to Appropriations Bills, Ways and Means Bills, Government Oversight Bills, Bills co-sponsored by Majority and Minority Leaders of one House, Companion Bills sponsored by the Majority Leaders of both Houses after consultation with the respective Minority Leaders, Conference Committee Reports, Concurrent or Simple Resolutions, Joint Resolutions nullifying Administrative Rules, Legalizing Acts, Administrative Rules Review Committee Bills, and Committee Bills related to delayed Administrative Rules [Iowa Code Sec. 17A.8(9)].
