Co-Chair Schuerer convened the meeting. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved on motion made by Rep. Connors and duly seconded. Roll was taken.

Dr. Edward J. Stanek II, Iowa Lottery Commissioner distributed information on the Iowa Lottery, including history and the regulation of the Lottery as detailed in the Iowa Code. Following the presentation, Dr. Stanek responded to questions from the committee.

Dr. Arthur Cox, Director of the Real Estate Education Program at The University of Northern Iowa, reviewed the program and distributed information. The program was created by the Legislature in 1989. Dr. Cox introduced Dr. Willis R. Greer, Jr., Dean of the College of Business Administration at UNI, who gave further comments on the program. Kara Case commented on the program from a student's perspective.

Kay Halloran, Administrator of the Professional Licensing & Regulation Division of the Department of Commerce, presented information on the licensing fees and the percentage going to the Real Estate Education Fund. The speakers responded to questions. Martin Lee, CEO of the Iowa Association of Realtors, responded to question from the viewpoint of the realtors.

Michael Fitzgerald, Treasurer of State, reviewed issues in which that office has been involved, including Vision Iowa, and distributed printed information. Mr. Fitzgerald was asked to provide information on funds remaining in the Iowa Seed Capital Corporation.
