Senator Schurer then introduced Dr. Owen Newlin, President Board of Regents.

Dr. Newlin spoke about the function of the Board of Regents. Dr. Newlin then introduced Gregory Nichols, Executive Director. Mr. Nichols made further remarks about the function and budget of the regents universities.
