

## COMMITTEE MINUTES for GOVERNMENT OVERSIGHT

Senator Lundby convened the Senate members of the committee at 11:05 AM. Roll call was taken. All committee members were present. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as published.

Senator Lundby announced that the committee would be considering SF 133, SSB 1298, the reassignment and consideration as a committee of the whole of SSB 1298, and the assignment of HF 536.

Senator Lundby recognized Senator Wieck for discussion of SF 133. The subcommittee report was received. Senator Wieck made opening remarks, then reviewed each section of the bill and recommended passage. Questions were responded to. Short form was requested. SF 133 was approved for passage as a committee bill.

Senator Lundby recognized Senator Connelly for SSB 1298. Senator Connelly submitted the subcommittee report and reviewed the bill. Sort form was requested. The bill was approved as a committee bill and moved to the calendar.

Senator Lundby announced that she was reassigning SSB 1296 as a committee of the whole, and she would be handling the bill. Senator Courtney assumed the chair and recognized Senator Lundby for opening remarks on SSB 1296. She discussed history of the bill and the need for passage. Short form was requested and the bill was approved as a committee bill and moved to the calendar; Senator Wieck asked to be recorded as a "no" vote.

Senator Courtney turned the meeting back to Senator Lundby. Senator Lundby then reviewed with the committee the bills that remain in Oversight. She stated that SSB 1275 will be considered when it comes from the House; SF 328 will be held over until 2006; SSB 1295 will be considered yet in 2005.

The next meeting of the committee is scheduled for Thursday, April 7, and with the unanimous approval of the committee, moved from 2:00 PM to noon.

Senator Wieck moved to rise at 11:35 AM.
