Senator Fraise called the meeting to order at 9:40 Am. Attendance was taken and the minutes were approved as printed.

Director Gary Maynard ,from the Department of Corrections discussed the risks in the prison system and how to reduce the risks.

Director Maynard addressed the questions from the previous meeting. They included suicides and their prevention, education, offender failure rates/recidivism and work outside the prison. He stated that work outside the prison included cleaning roadsides, pioneer cemeteries and many other projects. He said they also work inside the prison doing repairs. He stated that they cannot be used for repair if the cost is over \$25,000 dollars.
