The Administration and Regulation Budget Subcommittee was called to order at 9:35 a.m. on January 23, 2007.

Roll was taken and quorum was present.

Mark Schuling the Director of the Department of Revenue appeared before the subcommittee. Director Schuling summarized the Iowa Department of Revenue 2006 Annual Report. Stu Vos Administrator of the Revenue Operations Division presented an update on the Collections Enterprise. Mike Lipsman presented information on tax credits and the comprehensive credit tracking system.
