Technical Code Corrections/Clarifications

Programs for At-Risk Children (279.51) 279.51 1.a

AEAs provide services to a broader base of grantees and the current language does not include all grantees.

Expand “to assist school districts” to be more representative of current grantees. This expands the ability for the AEAs to serve more at-risk three and four year old children if the district does not provide it now; it extends reach to other providers such as Head Start and nonpublic schools.

The Department proposes this change to update archaic Iowa Code language.

Programs for At-Risk Children (279.51) 279.51 2.a(2)(a)

It is not a current practice to use Shared Vision grants for full-day kindergarten. Full-day kindergarten is funded by state aid formula.

To update archaic language, the Department proposes to remove “children which are a combination of preschool and full-day kindergarten.” End the language at “at-risk children.”
