The Iowa Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management is submitting a bill request to update the Iowa Individual Assistance Grant Program and Disaster Case Advocacy. These programs were brought under HSEMD starting July 1, 2023 following the implementation of last year's Senate File 514. However, these changes are being proposed after many years of familiarity with the program and through stakeholder engagement.

We propose adjusting the maximum eligible grant amount from \$5,000 to \$7,000 to account for inflation since the program's inception in 2007.

We also propose an additional definition of "local administrative entity" that will allow the Department to use a statewide provider as well as a qualified local provider in the administration of both the lowa Individual Assistance Grant Program as well as Disaster Case Advocacy.

HSEMD is proposing a modification to existing language in Iowa Code § 29C.2, 29C.20A, and 29C.20B.
