

## CHAPTER 1.

### CASS COUNTY.

AN ACT detaching the County of Cass from the Third Judicial District and annexing the same to the Fifth Judicial District.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the County of Cass is hereby detached from the Third Judicial District and annexed to the Fifth Judicial District.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance by the General Assembly, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Daily State Register and the Iowa Homestead, anything in the laws of this State to the contrary notwithstanding.

## CHAPTER 2.

### CASS COUNTY.

AN ACT fixing the time of holding Courts in the County of Cass in the Fifth Judicial District.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the District Court of the County of Cass of the Fifth Judicial District, shall be held at Lewis in said County on the first Thursday after the second Monday after the fourth Monday of March, and the first Monday after the fourth Monday of August, in each year.

SEC. 2. That all writs, processes and proceedings pending in said District Court and returnable at the terms now fixed by law, shall be deemed pending and
