All official acts, and ordinances, of trustees of Iowa Falls legalized.

SEC. 2. This act being of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the State Register and Iowa Falls Sentinel: *Provided*, such publication shall be without expense to the State.

CHAPTER 49.

LEGALIZING ACTS OF A DEPUTY RECORDER IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

AN ACT to Legalize the Acts of Ashford B. Elwood, a Deputy Recorder of Montgomery County, Iowa. MARCH 30.

WHEREAS, Ashford B. Elwood, a deputy recorder in and for Montgomery county, Iowa, performed official acts after the death of his principal, from the 13th day of November, A. D., 1868, until the 31st day of December, A. D., 1868; therefore,

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa*, That the official acts of the said Ashford B. Elwood, as deputy recorder of Montgomery county, Iowa, from the 13th day of November, A. D., 1868, until the 31st day of December, A. D., 1868, be and the same are hereby legalized, and made as valid, to all intents and purposes, as if no vacancy had occurred in the office of recorder.
