

## CHAPTER 131.

## SALARIES OF OFFICERS OF HOSPITALS FOR THE INSANE.

APRIL 14. AN ACT Supplementary to an Act, entitled an Act for the Government of Hospitals for the Insane, defining the Legal relations of Insane Persons, and providing for their Care and Protection.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa*, That the amount of the salaries of the superintendent and officers of the Insane asylum at Mt. Pleasant, be determined by the Board of Trustees of that institute[ion.]

## CHAPTER 132.

## INDEPENDENT SCHOOL-DISTRICT OF MISSOURI VALLEY.

APRIL 14. AN ACT to legalize the Organization of the Independent School-District of Missouri Valley, Harrison County, Iowa.

WHEREAS, On the twenty-fifth day of April, 1868, the trustees of the township of St. Johns, Harrison county, Iowa, in accordance with the result of an election held by the electors of sub-district number six, of the district-township of St. John, did declare the said sub-district to be an independent school-district, having for its territory section fifteen, and the north half of section twenty-two, in township seventy-eight, range forty-four; and,

Preamble.

WHEREAS, Doubts have arisen as to the legality of the organization of said independent school-district; therefore,

Doubts as to legality.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa*, That said independent school-district of Missouri Valley, county of Harrison, Iowa, be, and the
