

CHAPTER 149.

INDEPENDENT SCHOOL-DISTRICT OF SHELLSBURG.

APRIL 15. AN ACT to Legalize the Organization of, and the Election of the Independent School-District of Shellsburg, Benton County, Iowa.

Preamble. WHEREAS, In the organization of the independent school-district of Shellsburg, Benton county, Iowa, doubts have arisen as to the citizens therein having fully complied with the provisions of the statutes in such cases made and provided, and particularly in the election of directors in the omission of the giving full notice of the holding said election; therefore,

Doubts as to notice, etc.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa*, That the organization of the independent school-district of Shellsburg, Benton county, and the election of six directors therefor, are hereby legalized and made valid, to the same extent as if the organization of, and the election of six directors in, said independent school-district, had been made in strict conformity to the statutes in such cases made and provided.

Organization legalized.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in *The Vinton Eagle* and *People's Journal*, newspapers published at Vinton, Iowa.
