

## CHAPTER 184.

## RECORDS OF DEEDS OF CERTAIN LANDS.

APRIL 16. AN ACT to Amend Section 3 of Chapter 72 of the Laws of the Eleventh General Assembly.

1866 : chapter 72. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa*, That section 3 of chapter seventy-two of the acts of regular session of the Eleventh General Assembly of the State of Iowa, be and is hereby amended as follows, to-wit: That hereafter all deeds and other conveyances and writings affecting the south half of section thirty-four, in township sixty-seven, range five west, in Lee county, Iowa, shall be filed and recorded in the recorder's office in the city of Keokuk, Lee county, Iowa; and that the records of all deeds and other writings affecting said land, heretofore recorded in the recorder's office at the said city of Keokuk, is hereby legalized and declared duly recorded for all legal purposes whatever.

Conveyances affecting s & sec. 34, tp. 67, range 5, to be recorded in Keokuk.

Existing record legalized.

## CHAPTER 185.

## OFFENSES AGAINST PROPERTY.

APRIL 16. AN ACT to Amend Section 4235 of the Revision of 1860.

§4235 amended. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa*, That section 4235 of the Revision [of 1860] be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

SEC. 4235. If any person with intent to commit a felony, in the day-time, break and enter, or in the night time enter without breaking, any dwelling-house; or at any time break and enter any office, shop, store, warehouse, railroad-car, boat, or vessel, or any building in which any goods, merchandise, or valuable things are kept for use, sale, or deposit, he shall be punished by imprisonment in the Penitentiary not more than ten years, or by fine not exceeding five hundred dollars, and imprisonment in the county jail not more than one year.

Breaking-in in day-time, or entering at night, with felonious intent;

or at any time into railroad cars, etc; how punished.
