s. F. 55. AN ACT to amend Chapter 7, of Title 14, of the Code in relation to Assignments for the Benefit of Creditors.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:
Section 1. That hereafter in all assignments of property for

the benefit of creditors, whether under chapter 7, of title 14, of the Code, or at common law, assessments or taxes levied under the laws of the State, including municipal corporations, shall be entitled to priority or preference and be first paid in full.
