

thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to meet the requirements of an act known as the Military Code of Iowa, which are not otherwise provided for, and for payment of transportation of arms, ammunition and ordnance stores from the state arsenal to the various regimental and company headquarters of the Iowa national guard, and for the purchase of a seal for the adjutant-general's office. \$5,000 appropriated for transportation, &c.

SEC. 2. Said moneys shall be paid out only on vouchers duly certified by the adjutant-general, and approved by the governor, showing the necessity of such expenditure. Drawn on vouchers.

Two thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, may be drawn during the year 1878, and the balance, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be drawn during the year 1879.

SEC. 3. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect from and after its publication in the State Register and Iowa State Leader, newspapers published at Des Moines, Iowa. Publication.

CHAPTER 186.

FURNISHING SUPPLIES FOR THE PENITENTIARIES.

AN ACT Amendatory to Section 4773, of Chapter 2, Title XXVI, of the S. F. 285. Code, Relating to the Furnishing of Supplies for the Penitentiaries.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That section 4773 of the Code, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words: *Provided*, That the estimates of the warden shall first be submitted to, and approved by the governor and council before advertisement thereof; and *Provided further*, That all bills shall be submitted to the executive council, and that the awards of contracts for supplies shall be approved by such council. Code, § 4773, amended. Estimates to be approved by executive council.

SEC. 2. The provisions of section 4773 of the Code, and the amendments herein contained, are hereby made to govern all contracts for supplies for the additional penitentiary at Anamosa. Provisions to apply to additional penitentiary.

SEC. 3. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register, and Iowa State Leader, newspapers published at Des Moines, Iowa. Publication.
