FURNISH LAWS.

JOINT RESOLUTION requiring the secretary of state to furnish the counties of Warren and Madison with copies of the revised statutes and other laws of this state.

Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

That the secretary of state is hereby authorized and required to furnish the counties of Warren and Madison, each, with eight copies of the revised statutes and other laws of this state.

DUBUQUE HARBOR.

JOINT RESOLUTION relative to the improvement of the harbor at Dubuque.

Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

That our representatives be requested and our senators be instructed to use their influence to procure an appropriation from congress sufficient to complete the improvement of the harbor at Dubuque, which has been commenced by the general government and remains unfinished.

Resolved,

That the secretary of state be instructed to forward one copy of this resolution to the president of the senate, one to the speaker of the house of representatives, and one to each of our senators and representatives in congress.

DAVENPORT AND COUNCIL BLUFF RAILROAD.

JOINT RESOLUTION for a grant of land from congress.

Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

That the Hon. A. C. Dodge and G. W. Jones, our senators, and the Hon. Shepherd Leffler and William Thompson, our representatives in congress be requested to use their influence to procure from the government of the United States, a grant of land to aid in the construction of a railroad from Davenport via Bloomington, Iowa City, Fort Desmoines to some suitable point near the Council Bluffs, on the Missouri river.

Resolved,

That the Secretary of State be requested to forward a copy of this resolution to each of our senators and representatives in congress.
