## CHAPTER 1.

EXPENSES OF INAUGURATION AND DEDICATORY CEREMONIES.

AN ACT Appropriating Money to Defray Expenses of Inauguration 8. F. 6. and Dedicatory Ceremonies.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any seed appromoney in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated the atod. sum of two hundred and ninety-one dollars and fifty-five cents, or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay expenses incurred by the Inauguration and Dedicatory ceremonies.

SEC. 2. This act, being deemed by the General Assembly of Publication. immediate importance, shall be in force from and after its publication in the daily Iowa State Register, and daily Iowa State Leader, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
