## CHAPTER 58.

## ENDOWMENT FUND OF AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE.

AN ACT to Amend Chapter 193 of Laws of 20th General Assembly, H. F. 571.  
in Relation to the Management and Investment of the Endowment Fund of the Iowa Agricultural College.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. That section 3 of chapter 193 laws of 20th General Assembly of Iowa be and the same is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Contained" in the 4th line of said section as the same is printed in the session acts of said 20th General Assembly the following "And to take charge of the foreclosure of the mortgages and collection of bonds from delinquent debtors to said fund when so directed by the said trustees." Chapter 193,

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of said trustees upon the passage of this act to require the said financial agent to execute an additional bond in such sums as shall be fixed by the trustees conditioned for the faithful performance of the additional duties herein required, and for the payment into the State treasury of all sums of money which shall come into his hands belonging to such endowment fund. And when any such agent shall hereafter be appointed by said trustees his bond as required by said section three shall cover all the duties provided in said original section and in this act. Bond of financial agent.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines Leader, newspapers published at Des Moines Iowa. Publication.
