## CHAPTER 121.

### SUPPORT OF SOLDIERS' HOME AT MARSHALLTOWN.

AN ACT for the Support of the Soldiers' Home at Marshalltown s. f. 266.  
Iowa.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury the sum of six thousand (6000) dollars per annum for the salary and wages of the officers and employees of said Home. <sup>\$6,000 appro-</sup>  
<sup>prised.</sup>

SEC. 2. For the general support of the inmates of said Home there is hereby appropriated the sum of ten dollars per month, or so much thereof as may be necessary to each inmate in said Home to be estimated by the average number for the preceding quarter. <sup>Support of</sup>  
<sup>inmates.</sup>

SEC. 3. The above mentioned appropriation to be drawn monthly on the requisition of the Board of Commissioners of the Home in the usual manner and then only in such amounts as the wants of the Home may require. <sup>Appropriation</sup>  
<sup>drawn</sup>  
<sup>monthly.</sup>

SEC. 4. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and the *Des Moines Leader*, newspapers published in Des Moines Iowa. <sup>Publication.</sup>
