JOINT RESOLUTIONS

PASSED BY THE TWENTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

NUMBER 1.

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

That our representatives in the Senate and House of Representatives in Congress be requested to use their efforts to secure the passage of a bill which shall require that before judgments rendezed in the Federal Courts sitting in the State of Iowa shall become liens upon real estate, transcripts thereof shall be filed with the Clerk of the Court in the County where the real estate is located and be properly indexed.

NUMBER 2.

Be it resolved by the Twenty second General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

That our Senators and Representatives in Congress be and are hereby instructed and requested to favor the immediate repeal of that part of the pension law adopted March 3rd 1879, known as the "Arrears Limit" and further we recommend that they use their best endeavors in the future pension legislation, to secure the enactment of Law granting to all honorably discharged Soldiers and Sailors of the late War a service pension and also to use their utmost endeavor to secure the immediate adoption of the Prisoners-of-War pension bill. And that the Secretary of State be instructed to furnish each of our Sepators and Representatives in Congress with a copy of this memorial resolution.
