CHAPTER 86.

APPROPRIATION FOR INDUSTRIAL HOME FOR THE BLIND.

AN ACT making appropriations for the Industrial Home for the Blind. S. F. 143.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. That there is nereby appropriated for the industrial home for the blind at Knoxville, Iowa, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twenty thousand and three hundred dollars (\$20,300), or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purposes herein-after named, in the following sums and for the following purposes, to-wit:

For salaries of officers and employes and subsistence

Salaries. two years\$10,000 For material for manufactures for two years 3,000 Material. For additional furniture and machinery..... 2,500 Furniture. For grading and fencing grounds and making walks Work on and outbuildings and driveways..... grounds. 2.000 For contingent fund 1,500 Contingent. 1,000 Ice house. For ice house and cold storage..... 300 Planting. For planting orchard and small fruits......

The money herein appropriated shall be drawn To be paid on and paid on the order of the commissioners appointed under chapter fifty-three of the acts of the Twenty-third General assembly, until such a time as the trustees who may be appointed by law shall take permanent control of said home, after which time the same shall be drawn and paid on the order of such trustees, in such sums as they may deem neces- Trustees. sary: provided that not more than one half of the said sum of \$10,000 for salaries of officers and employes, and subsistence shall be drawn during the year 1892.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall Publication take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines Leader, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
