GENERAL LAWS.

CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT to amend sections 289 and 290 of the Code of 1873 as S. F. 88.
amended by chapter 76 of the acts of the Twenty-sixth General
Assembly of the State of Iowa relating to the bonding of county
indebtedness.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That section 289 of the Code of 1873, as
amended by chapter 76 of the laws of the Twenty-sixth
General Assembly, be and the same is hereby amended as
follows:

Strike out of the second line of said section 289 the
words "the first day of March, 1896," and insert in lieu
thereof the words "first day of April, 1897." Sec. 289
amended.

SEC. 2. Strike out of said section 290 as amended by
chapter 76 of the laws of the Twenty-sixth General Assem-
bly of Iowa the words, "on the first day of March, 1896,"
and insert in lieu thereof the words, "on the first day of
April, 1897." Sec. 290
amended.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
this act are hereby repealed. Repealing
clause.

SEC. 4. This act being deemed of immediate impor-
tance shall take effect and be in force from and after pub-
lication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines
Leader. Take effect.
