CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT to authorize the transfer of county road funds to the county S. F. 22. fund and county bridge fund.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. The board of supervisors of any county in Transfer of this state that now has a surplus in its county road fund, surplus road which is not needed for the purpose for which it was levied, county or may transfer said surplus or so much thereof as shall by bridge fund. the said board seem best to the county fund or the county Money colbridge fund for the use and benefit of such funds. Provided, lected provided to Indiana. that this section shall apply only to money collected prior to January 1, to January 1, 1896, and to such counties as have levied said county road tax and collected the same in the incorporated Counties to towns and cities as well as the territory outside of said which applicities.
