SEC. 2. It is hereby made the duty of the auditor of Auditor of state to cancel and surrender to said asylum any and all state to cancelligations of said asylum which the state may hold for said loan, and if the mortgage given to secure said loan has been made a matter of record, then and in that event the said auditor shall satisfy said mortgage of record.

## CHAPTER 114.

AN ACT to levy a tax to provide for the erection of necessary H. F. 188, buildings for the State university of Iowa.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. That for the purpose of providing for the Tax of one-erection, improvement, and equipment of such necessary tenth of a buildings as shall be determined upon by the board of erection of regents of the state university there shall be levied a buildings. special tax of one-tenth (1-10) of a mill on the dollar upon the assessed valuation of the taxable property of the state for the erection of buildings for the state university; and the proceeds thereof shall be carried into the treasury to the credit of said state university, said levy to commence Levy to comwith the first levy made after the passage of this act; the mence with same levy shall be made annually after said first levy for made after four (4) successive years. Any amount in excess of the passage of sum of fifty-five thousand dollars raised by any one of such levies shall be paid into the state treasury.

SECTION 2. The money realized from such a levy shall Money to be be held by the treasurer of state; and drawn as provided held by in chapter 31 of the acts of the Twenty-third General urer.

SECTION 3. The amounts so realized by said levies shall be in lieu of all appropriations for the erection of buildings for said state university during said period of five years.
