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H. F. 348.

AN ACT to repeal section sixteen hundred and fifty-four [1654] of the code and enact a substitute therefor.
Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ionoa:
Section 1. Officers Agricultural society. That section sixteen hundred and fifty-four (16E4) of the code be and the same is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:
"The cfficers chosen at such meeting shall be a president, vicepresident and five directors. The president and vice-president shall hold (ffice cne year and be directors by virtue of their office. The other dircciors shall strve two years, so that the entire number shall always $t e$ ten, one half of whom shall be chosen annually, and six of whom shall constitute a quorum. The term of office of directors, other than president and vice-president, shall be two yfars, except vacancies shall ke filled cnly until the next annual meeting. The board shall elect a secretary and treasurer, whose terms of office shall be one year, and the board may fill any vacancy in office until the next annual meeting. The president or a majority of the koard may call meetings of the board when the interests of the society require action by the beard."
